- Pre-emptive bids

To Bid or not to bid?

Less than 12 points: Pass

• 12 to 19 points: Open at one level

Types of opener

No trump

• 5+ card suit

• 4 card suit

Bidding Filter

Less than 12 pts
Pass

12-14 pts balanced Bid 1NT

• 5+ card suit(s) Bid (higher) one

• 4 card suit(s) Bid (lowest) one

Response to 1NT opener

- 0-10 pts balanced Pass
- 0-10 pts long suit Bid two of suit
- 11-12 pts balanced Bid 2NT
- 13+ pts balanced Bid 3NT
- 13+ pts long suit Force to game

Response to 1 of suit

- 0-5 pts pass
- 6+ pts Start looking for
 - Major suit fit
 - No trump contract
 - Minor suit fit

Remember: partner is promising another bid so no need to rush things

Subsequent bidding

- Both players need to be thinking
 - What level do we want to be at?
 - What suit do we want to be in?
